
The Kingdom

Jesus's understanding of the kingdom can be summed up in the following:

The Kingdom of God is within your consciousness. It is the place centered on God's love. The Kingdom of God is where the bond of God's love is made, established and harmonized with the essence of God's love.

And he said: Truly I tell you, unless you change and become like little children, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven." (Matt 18:3)

Unity Co-founder, Charles Fillmore stated: Had the kingdom, to which Jesus so often referred, been a city with golden streets in the skies, He could easily have located it; but He did not do so. On the contrary, He again and again gave illustrations to show His listeners that it was a desirable condition, which would be brought about among them through the power of Spirit.

David's Story:

One day I got a call informing me that David had an accident while driving to one of his accounts and was in the hospital. He was pretty banged up but would be okay. A week later after he was able to get around we went to the towing company and looked at this truck.

As we stood there I couldn't help but think, God, David, you're lucky to be alive. "Yea," he responded. "It was like I was in slow motion as I saw this tractor trailer coming straight at me, I had no place to go, nothing to do but just sit there and wait for the crash to come. Strange as it was, I wasn't scared. Something inside of me told me I would be okay."

It was about a month later I saw him eating at a local restaurant.

I noticed that across from him was a place setting as if he was waiting for someone to join him for lunch. I walked over and asked how he was doing. He said, "Great." I then asked if someone was joining him and he said, "He's already here." As I looked at him kinda funny he told me to sit down.

He said. "After the accident I became aware of how much I have wasted my life. That there had to be more I could be doing to make things better, not only for me but for everyone around me."

And since then I have developed this relationship with God. I talk with Him about everything. He rides in my truck wherever I go. He's with me on my walks on the beach and when I'm out eating alone, I'll get a table for two, like the one you see here. I can't really explain it, and you may not want anything to do with me, but I'm not crazy. I have become aware of this presence and I can't go back to who I once was. That accident was the best thing that ever happened to me.
