So here is some spiritual insight from Barbara Cage that can help realize how important each of us is to others around us in spite of the storms in our lives.

Never Give Up Hope, by Barbara Cage:

"Life doesn't always give us the joys we want. We don't always get our hopes and dreams, and we don't always get our own way. But don't give up hope, because you can make a difference one situation and one person at a time.

Look for the beauty around you – in nature, in others, in yourself – and believe in the love of friends, family, and humankind.

You can find love in a smile or a helping hand, in a thoughtful gesture or a kind word. It is all around, if you just look for it. Give love, for in giving it you will find the power in life along with the joy, happiness, patience, and understanding. Believe in the goodness of others and remember that anger and depression can be countered by love and hope. Even when you feel as though there isn't a lot you can do to change unhappiness or problems, you can always do a little – and a little at a time eventually makes a big difference."

To help us maintain our awareness that we are always connected to God, Unity teaches the Three R's: Recognize; Remember; and Rejoice.

Recognize that when you find yourself in a storm and facing the turbulent winds swirling around you, know that God is with you.

Remember that no matter what, you have the power to say, "Peace be still!" You have the power to connect directly with the source of your being to clam and still the winds.

Who You Gonna Call

- 2. It is open-ended, allowing the highest possibilities.
- 3. It's about aligning ourselves with universal principles and holding the "High Watch" for others.
- 4. It's heart-felt and sincere, grateful and trusting.

- 5. We state the need.
- 6. We become still breathe and go to the heart.
- 7. We deny our belief that the condition has power over us.
- 8. We stay centered in the realization and consciousness awareness of the divine presence.
- 9. Give thanks in advance.
